KNOCK-OUT COMPETITION

A draw will be made from all entries. The first named member in any pairing will have choice of venue. The final will be played on a neutral course to be agreed by the finalists or, if preferred, on their home course in the event of both being members of the same club.

The low handicap player in each match will not receive any shots. The high handicap player will receive the number of shots calculated from the difference between the **full** handicaps of the players (except where additional adjustment is required for different men's and ladies' SSS). That will test our mathematical ability !

Although end dates are set for each round, we would encourage that all matches are played well in advance of these dates if possible. Early completion presents no problems, whereas matches held at the last minute can lead to difficulties, especially during the holiday season.

RULES

- 1) The competition shall be Match Play; the gentlemen to play from the yellow tees and the ladies from the red tees. The lower handicap player in each match shall not receive any strokes and the higher handicap player shall receive strokes calculated from the full difference between the handicaps. A lady may receive additional shots if there is a difference between the men's and ladies' SSS for the course being played
- 2) In the event of a match being all square after 18 holes, play will continue until one of the players wins a hole.
- 3) The name shown in **red** for each match has the right to choose the course for the match and is responsible for communicating with his/her opponent to arrange a date and time for the match. This does not prevent his/her opponent from initiating contact if there seems to be a delay in making the necessary arrangements. Please note that work commitments mean that Mike Coates is available to play only at weekends.
- 4) The winner of each match is responsible for notifying Nick Roberts / Eddie Faulkner of the result by the date for completion of each round, or earlier if possible.
- 5) In the event of a player failing to meet the agreed match appointment, his/her opponent will be declared the winner.
- 6) There is no charge for entering this competition. However, the players in each match are both requested to pay half of the total green fees for their match.
